Invitation

Greetings to you all. We, Asian Business scholars meet for a symposium under the theme of 'Win-win Growth in Korea-World Chinese Business'.

As the global economy is contracted due to COVID-19 and the era of deglobalization that each country seeks its own interests is accelerating, business activities are becoming increasingly difficult. In particular, the trade war between the US and China and the trade conflict between Korea and Japan are raising the uncertainty of the domestic and international political and economic environment. Korea, which has enjoyed the benefits of the era of globalization through export-led growth so far, is facing even greater difficulties due to hegemonic race between powerful countries. As an alternative to overcome this, the Moon Jaein government is advocating the new southern policy, developing a new economic bloc centered on the Indochina Peninsula. Especially, in Southeast Asia, overseas Chinese entrepreneurs dominate the economy, so the network with them is essential. The population of the world Chinese entrepreneurs is about 60 million, and their assets are about 3 trillion dollars. In particular, 9 of the 10 richest people in Southeast Asia are the Chinese, and they dominate 70% of the Southeast Asian economy. In this situation, we are holding an international symposium during the "Korea-World Chinese Entrepreneurs Business Week" hosted by Changwon City, where Southeast Asian business scholars and Chinese entrepreneurs gather together to seek new vitality in Asia-centered economy. Due to COVID-19, only those who have applied for the participation in advance can enter

the venue, and those who cannot attend the site can participate in real time through the Youtube and Zoom. Please apply in advance even if you are busy, and if you are unable to attend, I sincerely ask that you make it an active forum for sharing good opinions online.
